

## Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or their licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.



1. ALCOHOL SHALL NOT BE SOLD OR SUPPLIED EXCEPT DURING PERMITTED HOURS. IN THIS CONDITION, PERMITTED HOURS MEANS:

BETWEEN 0800 HOURS AND 2300 HOURS MONDAY TO SATURDAY BETWEEN 1000 HOURS AND 2230 HOURS SUNDAY BETWEEN 0800 HOURS AND 2230 HOURS GOOD FRIDAY BETWEEN 1200 HOURS AND 1500 HOURS AND BETWEEN 1900 HOURS AND 2230 HOURS ON CHRISTMAS DAY

THE ABOVE RESTRICTIONS DO NOT PROHIBIT:

A) DURING THE FIRST TWENTY MINUTES AFTER THE ABOVE HOURS, THE TAKING OF THE ALCOHOL FROM THE PREMISES, UNLESS THE ALCOHOL IS SUPPLIED OR TAKEN IN AN OPEN VESSEL;

B) THE ORDERING OF ALCOHOL TO BE CONSUMED OFF THE PREMISES, OR THE DESPATCH BY THE VENDOR OF THE ALCOHOL SO ORDERED;

C) THE SALE OF ALCOHOL TO A TRADER OR CLUB FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE TRADE OR CLUB;

D) THE SALE OR SUPPLY FO ALCOHOL TO ANY CANTEEN OR MESS, BEING A CANTEEN IN WHICH THE SALE OR SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL IS CARRIED OUT UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE OR AN AUTHORISED MESS OF MEMBERS OF HER MAJESTY'S NAVAL, MILITARY OR AIR FORCES.

## 2.

ALCOHOL SHALL NOT BE SOLD IN AN OPEN CONTAINER OR BE CONSUMED IN THE LICENSED PREMISES.

3.

NO CHILD SHALL BE EMPLOYED SO LONG AS HE/SHE IS UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS TO DO ANY WORK OTHER THAN LIGHT WORK OR BEFORE THE CLOSE OF SCHOOL HOURS ON ANY DAY ON WHICH HE/SHE IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND SCHOOL OR BEFORE 7 O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING OR AFTER 7 O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING ON ANY DAY OR FOR MORE THAN 2 HOURS ON ANY DAY ON WHICH HE/SHE IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND SCHOOL OR FOR MORE THAN 2 HOURS ON ANY DAY ON WHICH HE/SHE IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND SCHOOL OR FOR MORE THAN 2 HOURS ON A SUNDAY OR MORE THAN 35 HOURS, OR IF HE/SHE IS UNDER THE AGE OF 15 YEARS, FOR MORE THAN 25 HOURS IN ANY WEEK IN WHICH HE/SHE IS NOT REQUIRED TO ATTEND SCHOOL OR FOR MORE THAN 4 HOURS IN ANY DAY WITHOUT A REST BREAK OF 1 HOUR OR AT ANY TIME IN A YEAR UNLESS AT THAT TIME HE OR SHE HAS HAD, OR COULD STILL HAVE, DURING THE PERIOD IN THE YEAR IN WHICH HE IS NOT REQUIRED TO ATTEND SCHOOL, AT LEAST TWO CONSECUTIVE WEEKS WITHOUT EMPLOYMENT.
