On the afternoon of Friday 22nd January 2010, I was involved in a Police Operation targeting the sale of alcohol to persons under the age of 18 years. My role within the operation was to enter specified off licensed premises in an attempt to purchase alcohol. I was fully briefed by the Police prior to commencement of the operation during which I provided them with a copy of my Passport, College Card and I had three photographs taken. I had a quick look around the shop before selecting 6 cans of Carlsberg Lager and a box of Pringles Crisps that I then took to the counter.

There were two people working in the shop. There was an Asian male together with a white female who was stood behind the counter.
