#### Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or their licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

When a film is exhibited, admission of children to that part of the premises must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the British Board of Film Classification in relation to that film.

#### Conditions imposed by virtue of paragraph 6(8) Schedule 8 Licensing Act 2003

Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours. In this condition, permitted hours means:

Between 1000 hours and 0100 hours Monday to Thursday.

Between 1000 hours and 0200 hours Friday and Saturday.

Between 1000 hours and 0100 hours Sunday only.

On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of permitted hours on the following day.

Between 1000 hours and 0200 hours on New Year's Day.

Between 1000 hours and 0200 hours on Christmas Eve, Boxing Day and each Sunday and Monday of recognised English Bank Holiday weekends.

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

During the first twenty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;

During the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;

During the first thirty minutes after the above hours the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied for consumption as ancillary to the meals;

Consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;

The ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;

The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;

The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of state or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;

The taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or

The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by person so supplied; or

The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

#### Conditions imposed by virtue of being consistent with the operating schedule

The licence holder and/or the designated premises supervisor or a person nominated by them shall be a member of and regularly attend at the meetings of the Pub, Club or Off Watch schemes for the area within which the premises is located.

There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public, (or member and their guests) notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.

All external windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided from 2200 hours.

Persons who appear to be under the age of 18 years shall be required to produce proof of age by way of one of the following:

- \* A recognised proof of age card accredited under the British Retail Consortiums Proof of Age Standards Scheme (PASS)
- \* Photo driving licence
- \* Passport
- \* Citizen card supported by the Home Office
- \* Official ID card issued by HM Forces or European Union bearing a photograph and date of birth of the holder

The maximum number of persons, including staff, allowed in these premises shall be 100.

When regulated entertainment is provided by way of live music, a maximum of two performers at any one time shall be permitted to perform in the licensed area.

#### **Plans**

The plans received by the Licensing Authority on 28th June 2011 and held by the Licensing Authority refer.

These conditions came into force on 6th April 2010.

- The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children:
  - games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to:
    - drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
    - ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
  - provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in Section 159 of the Act);
  - provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less.
  - provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on:
    - i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
    - ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
  - selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters on, or in the vicinity
    of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or
    glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any
    favourable manner.
- The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

- 1. (1.) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

    - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125ml; and
  - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures
