- 5.2 At the Governance Working Group meeting on 13th June members discussed increasing the membership of the Development Control Committee (as detailed at 8.01 point 1) from seven to nine members.

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- 5.3 Following discussion Governance Working Group recommended the proposal to Full Council for decision.
- 5.4 Should the proposed be approved it will require the political balance to be amended and reissued accordingly.

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ARTICLE 8 - REGULATORY COMMITTEES

8.01 Regulatory Committees

The Council will appoint:

1. A **Development Control Committee** of seven-nine Members.

No Member may serve on the Development Control Committee who has not undertaken the appropriate training in order to take part in the committee's work.
