# 6. REPORT TO CONSIDER THE REVIEW OF A HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE FOR MMK (ITEM C2)

The chair welcomed the licence holder and his representative to the Sub-Committee.

The Licensing Manager presented the report and detailed the circumstances that had brought the licence holder before the Sub-Committee.

The licence holder and representative presented their case to the Sub-Committee.

The Sub-Committee members asked questions for clarification purposes only.

The licence holder, representative and Licensing Manager left the room to enable the Sub-Committee to come to a decision.

## Resolved:

- 1. That the licence holder be required to take and pass the DVSA test (or council approved equivalent) and provide evidence of this to the Licensing and Enforcement Unit within a period of 3 months (unless evidence was provided that an appointment could not be obtained). Failure to provide such evidence within 3 months would result in being called back to the Sub-Committee.
- 2. The licence holder was informed of their right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court which must be exercised within 21 days of service of the decision letter upon them.
- 3. The licence holder was informed of the reason for the decision and that they would receive written confirmation of the council's decision.

# Reason for Decision

The matter had been considered in accordance with the council's approved procedure, the Council's Guidelines on Convictions, Byelaws relating to Hackney Carriages and the Sub-Committee took into account all the relevant information put before them.

# 7. REPORT TO CONSIDER THE REVIEW OF A PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE FOR BM (ITEM C3) AND THE REVIEW OF A HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE FOR BM (ITEM C4)
