Consideration of the Rossendale Council Licensing policy has been carried out to ensure the promotion of the four licensing objectives.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

An Digital Camera CCTV system will be in use covering all licensed areas. A camera will be focused on public entry and exit points. The CCTV system will continually record whilst the premises are open for licensable activities and during alltimes that customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days and can be accessed onsite.

Viewings of any recordings shall be made available on request to the Police or any other authorised officers.

The premises licence holder shall ensure the CCTV system is maintained at regular intervals.

A record will be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The record should include the date and time of the refusal and include the staff member who refused the sale. This refusal log will be made available to the police or any authorised officer of the council upon request, whilst the premises are open.

c) Public safety

The premises will be maintained in a safe manner at all times.

All exits will be cleared of hazards.

All staff will be trained in emergency procedures and records maintained

d) The prevention of public nuisance

All refuse will be disposed of in an appropriate manner. Staff will be instructed to maintain all external

in a clean and presentable manner at all times.

No bottle bins will be emptied before 10.00 am.

e) The protection of children from harm

A Challenge 25 age verification policy will be implemented on the premises. The only acceptable forms of identification will

be recognised photographic identification cards such as passports, driving licences or forces ID cards. Also acceptable

are cards that carry the PASS logo.

Staff will be trained to understand the above policies. Training records will be maintained and these will be made available

to authorised officers if requested by the police or any other responsible authorised officer.

No unaccompanied children under the age of 18 will be permitted after 20.00 hours.
