1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

The purpose of this report is to inform Overview and Scrutiny about the progress made during 06/07 by the Rossendale Partnership in delivering the actions in its delivery plan 2006-09.

2. CORPORATE PRIORITIES

Embedding Our Customer Promise Promoting Rossendale Equalities

3. RISK ASSESSMENT IMPLICATIONS

Failure to deliver the actions in the Rossendale Partnership delivery plan would mean that the Council has had little impact in working with its partners to improve the lives of people in the Borough.

4. BACKGROUND/REASON FOR REPORT

- 4.2 Overview and Scrutiny have requested a report detailing the Rossendale Partnerships achievements against its delivery plan to date.
- 4.3 The Rossendale Partnership monitors the performance of its delivery plan using Covalent. Chairs are required to report against the actions in their delivery plan at quarterly LSP Executive meetings using the traffic light system of assessment.
- 4.4 There are a total of 41 objectives in the three year delivery plan (2006-09) each having a number of actions associated with them.
- 4.5 Of the 41 objectives in the LSP delivery plan:

6 are blue - completed.
26 are green - on target to achieve
8 are amber - up to a quarter behind target
1 is red - More than a quarter behind target or unlikely to deliver.

- 4.6 Good progress is being made in delivering the objectives set out in the Rossendale Partnership three year delivery plan. Almost 80% of objectives are either completed or on target to be achieved by March 2009.
- 4.7 Almost half (20) of the objectives in the delivery plan are to be completed by March 07. Of the 20 objectives for 2007:

6 are blue - completed

9 are green – on target to achieve by March 07

4 amber – up to a quarter behind target of March 07

1 is red – More than a quarter behind target or unlikely to deliver.

- 4.8 We can conclude that 75% (15) of the objectives for 2007 will be achieved.
- 4.9 The remaining 25% (5) of objectives for 2007 are unlikely to be delivered on time. These are:
 - To improve transition between primary and secondary school. (Education)
 - Improved choice in older people's housing options (Housing)
 - Increase economic inclusion by encouraging social and community enterprise (Regeneration)
 - Develop a competitive, comprehensive and integrated economic development, enterprise and business support service. (Regeneration)
 - Develop a food manufacturing retail park. (Regeneration)
- 4.10 The LSP has in place actions to achieve all of the targets with the exception of the food manufacturing retail park.
