5. PROPOSAL TO INTRODUCE:

Members of the Council considered the report of the Monitoring Officer relating to the referral from Overview and Scrutiny to reconsider the decision taken by Cabinet on the 14th November 2007 to increase the fees for hackney carriage and private hire drivers' licences together with the introduction of an annual fee and annual statutory declaration.

The Chair invited questions from members of the public however no questions were raised.
