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4. BACKGROUND AND OPTIONS

- 4.1 At a meeting of the Licensing Committee, held on the 8th of October 2007, the following matter relating to a proposal to increase the Hackney Carriage Taximeter Tariff and Soiling Charge was resolved.
- 4.2 That the Tariff 1 flag be increased to £2.50 for the first mile.
- 4.3 That the soiling charge be increased to £50.
- 4.4 That the extra charges within the 'Table of Fares' be revised as follows:
 - Extra Charges For hiring between midnight and 06:00 and on Sundays and Statutory Holidays (except Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day): +50% of mileage charge (Tariff 2).
 - That 'and on Sundays' be removed from the current Table of Fares.
 - That the time stated for extra charges be changed to 'between 02:00 and 06:00am'.
- 4.5 That (subject to correct advertising and any objections received) the above changes be implemented by 26th November 2007.
- 4.6 This matter was subsequently put on hold for further consultation and a new proposal has been submitted by the Taxi Association details of which are appended at appendix 1.
- 4.7 Due to the current economical climate relating to the increases in fuel charges, there is a second option appended at Appendix 2.
