Dear Sir,

I wish to object to the License Application in respect of the Crown Inn (Bacup) Limited

I understand they are applying for permission to open till 1-30 am at weekends with provision of live music O.J and recorded music.

If this license is granted it will have a dramatic impact on the surrounding environs and will impact severely upon our peaceful existence.

My objection is based on the following facts.

Greave is a sleepy backwater of Bacup and is exclusively made up of middle to elderly age group and some families with very young children. There is no commercial developments what so ever in the area and the noise pollution from intended music and O.J will be devastating.

The Crown Inn is only singly glazed and therefore will transmit sound readily. I see nothing in the application

Whereby the owners intend to install sound-proofing.

Road infrastructure. Gleave Road is a single carriage way which is already a cause for concern for local residents turning into Gleave Road owing to Crown Inn customers' cars parked on both sides of the road.

* The intended custom of the Crown Inn is likely to be young teenagers (by virtue of the attraction of music dancing) and very late drinking.

This will obviously result in unruly behaviour and vandalism by departing customers.

I ask you to think very carefully on what is being asked for in the new licence.

Nobody wants to live next door to a Discotheque or night Club (for surely, that's what this application is for) it is totally out of character for a mature residential locality and would be far more in keeping with a town centre location I feel it is totally unacceptable to have opening hours in excess of those that presently pertain.

The landlord of the Crown Inn has tried before to get this licence through which upset all the residents living in Gleave.
