1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To request the committee to formally amend a typographical error in the list of prohibited streets that has been adopted by Rossendale Borough Council to regulate street trading in the Borough.

4. BACKGROUND AND OPTIONS

- 4.1 Schedule 4 of The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 makes provisions for the regulation of street trading. This allows a Local Authority to designate particular streets as prohibited, consent or licensed streets. These are defined as follows:
 - A Prohibited Street means a street where trading is prohibited;
 - A Consent Street is where street trading is prohibited without the consent of the Council

- A Licensed Street is where street trading is prohibited without a licence granted by the Council.
- 4.2 Rossendale Borough Council, by resolution on the 7th October 2009, designated a number of locations as 'prohibited streets' within the Borough and designated the remainder as 'Consent Streets.' One of the locations in Waterfoot designated as a prohibited street was described as:

Bacup Road from the junction of Church Road to the junction of Cowpe Road.

4.3 The location should read as follows:

Bacup Road from the junction of <u>Church Street</u> to the junction of Cowpe Road.

4.4. In all other respects, the street locations for prohibited and consent streets remains the same.
