#### 1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To advise members of an objection received with regard to the proposed Hackney Carriage fares increase.

#### 2. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 The Licensing Committee are recommended to resolve to:
  - a) approve the proposal of the previous Licensing Manager; or
  - b) approve the proposal made by the objector; or
  - c) decide and approve alternative fares

with effect from 1st January 2006.

# 3. REPORT AND REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS AND TIMETABLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION

- 3.1 On 30<sup>th</sup> August 2005, Committee resolved to increase the Hackney Carriage fares as follows:
  - a) First 1609 metres (1 mile) £2.30 Subsequent 402.25 metres 43p (quarter of a mile)
- 3.2 The proposed table of fares was advertised in the Rossendale Free Press on 16<sup>th</sup> September 2005.
- 3.3 After the objection expiry date, it was brought to the attention of the current Licensing Manager that Anne Kenyon had made representation to the proposed fares increase.

- 3.4 The report submitted to committee on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2005, from the previous Licensing Manager referred to representations from members of the trade.
- 3.5 It was therefore decided to be in the best interest of all concerned to readvertise the proposed Hackney Carriage fares increase. The increase was then advertised on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2005.
- 3.6 The Licensing Manager wrote to every operator within the Borough requesting their views to the increase. No responses were received in relation to this. (See Appendix A).
- 3.7 An objection was received from Kenyons Taxi's (See Appendix B).
- 3.8 The current fares, proposed increase and the objector's recommendations are listed below:

Subsequent 321.8 metres (fifth of a mile)	32p		34p

3.9 Members are requested to consider that current fares after midnight are increased by 50% and that the implementation of the Licensing Act 2003 should result in a sharp increase in night time trade due to extended liquor licensing hours.
