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1.	RECOMMENDATION(S)
1.1	It is recommended that the Licensing Committee determine to appoint a hackney carriage stand for ten hackney carriages at the Bus Station on Bacup Road, Rawtenstall under section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.
1.2	It is further recommended that the hackney carriage stands hours of operation should be Monday to Sunday, 23.30 to 05.30.
1.3	The Licensing Committee are recommended to delegate all matters relating to the appointment of the hackney carriage stand to the Public Protection Manager in consultation with the Chair of Licensing.

2. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 2.1 To request the Committee agree to increase the current hackney carriage stand for 4 hackney carriages at the Bus Station in Bacup Road, Rawtenstall by formally appointing a hackney carriage stand for ten hackney carriages under section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.
- 2.2 To request the Committee agree to an operation time for the said hackney carriage stand from 23.30 to 05.30.
- 2.3 To request the Committee delegate all matters relating to the appointment of the hackney carriage stand to the Public Protection Manager in consultation with the Chair of Licencing..

3. CORPORATE PRIORITIES

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5. BACKGROUND AND OPTIONS

- 5.1 Rossendale Borough Council licences hackney carriage drivers and vehicles, and private hire drivers, vehicles and operators under the provisions of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.
- 5.2 Private hire drivers and vehicles are operated through private hire operators and are not permitted to ply for hire or wait on hackney carriage stands.
- Hackney carriages are one of the oldest forms of public transport and an important part of the overall passenger transport infrastructure of the country. Hackney carriages can ply for hire in a street or other public places and indeed, by virtue of bye-laws within the Borough of Rossendale, are obliged to return to a hackney carriage stand after completing each hire.
- The adoption of a taxi stand makes it an offence under Section 64 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 for any person to cause or permit any vehicle other than a hackney carriage to wait on any stand for hackney carriages during any period for which that stand has been appointed, or is deemed to have been appointed, by a district council under the provisions of section 63 of the Act.
- 5.5 Current details of hackney carriage stands appointed under section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 by Rossendale Borough Council are appended at Appendix A.
- 5.6 The current hackney carriage stand at the Bus Station on Bacup Road, Rawtenstall, is a stand for 4 hackney carriage vehicles between the hours of 23.00 and 05.00 Monday to Sunday on stands D and E. This stand was appointed on 22nd October 1982.
- Due to a recent change to the operation of the bus times which impacts on the operation of the hackney carriage stand, it is proposed to re-appoint the hackney carriage stand for 10 vehicles spanning from stand D to H (Appendix B) of the Bus Station and change the time of operation to 23.30 to 05.30 Monday to Sunday.
