- The Task and Finish Group visited the Boiler House (formerly White Horse Project), the young people services based in the Old Fire Station in Rawtenstall and Engage, which was established when members of St Mary's Church walked the streets of Balladen 'engaging' with young people.
- 5.3 A presentation was received from Rossendale Leisure Trust, who gave an overview of the range of sports services available to young people.
