  - The group need to look more in-depth at the operational structure to find out what has changed and how GVH can influence and work with the Council and vice-versa.
  - To look at issues around new developments in terms of consultation and communication.
- 5.2 Meetings were held between 11<sup>th</sup> September 2014 and 16<sup>th</sup> February 2015, during which time the task and finish group heard from the two Council representatives on the Green Vale Homes Board, a representative from the CAB, numerous Officers from both GVH and the Together Housing Group, including their Chief Executive, Steve Close.

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- 5.3 Once the final report had been produced it was sent to the Chief Executive and the Director of Strategy and Communications at Together Housing Group for comments and they were invited to attend the final meeting of the task and finish group on 12<sup>th</sup> March to discuss the report and its recommendations in more detail.
- 5.4 The report, attached as Appendix A, includes the comments of the Together Housing Group/GVH Officers.
