There will be operational, financial and resource implications for the Council in undertaking this review and the required consultation which, at the time of writing, have not been quantified. However a number of service areas will be involved, amongst others: Elections, Democratic Services, Communications and ICT.

Legal implications: An interim polling district review (in addition to the statutory 5 year review) can only be instigated by a majority decision at full council (as per the advice of the Electoral Commission). The review process usually takes about 3 months and a public consultation is required.	Date: 02/07/2015
Risk implications: Staffing/time required to undertake a review would reduce the time available to work on the canvass for the	



new register. The new register is required to be published on 1<sup>st</sup> December. Resource limitations may also impact on the quality of a review at the present time. If the review was finished after 1<sup>st</sup> December, it would require the register to be re-published (as this must be done following changes to boundaries).

## Resource implications:

Additional officer support time would be required from Elections, Legal, Committee and Member Services, Communications and IT teams in supporting the review process and in the publication/ production of maps of polling district boundaries and in updating the LLPG.

## **Cost implications:**

Some of the consultation review documents must be published in paper format for which there will be cost implications.
