## 1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1. This report is to consider the request of The Queen's Lancashire Regiment to transfer the current Freedom of the Borough to the newly formed Duke of Lancaster's Regiment due to form on 1st July 2006.

2.1. That the Council agree to the proposed transfer of the Freedom of the Borough of the Queen's Lancashire Regiment to the newly formed "The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment (King's, Lancashire and Border), to take effect from 1st July, 2006.

3.1 The Queen's Lancashire Regiment were granted the Freedom of the Borough in June, 2002. The new Regiment will become "The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment (King's, Lancashire and Border) on the 1st July, 2006. The Regiment wish to re-emphasise their close and long-standing local links, in particular with those Boroughs that have honoured them with their Freedom and have formally requested the Council to consider transferring that Freedom to The Duke of Lancaster's Regiment.
