<p>Dog fouling is a disgusting anti social act, it also carries serious health risks. The majority of complaints received by the Operations Team and Ward Councillors across the Valley concern this.</p> <p>We the undersigned feel the most effective way of dealing with this would be the employment of a full time Dog Warden. This person would be responsible for enforcement and education.</p> <p>This would be funded using the amount currently paid as RBCs contribution to the shared service and a levy of 5% on the total allowance paid to each of the 36 Councillors.</p>

<p>Comments:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 5% of all Member allowances is c £9k. There is no other budget provision for a shared service. We do, however, have a c £24k provision for dog kennelling with an expected saving of c £4k. Therefore potential available budget resources £13k. 2. Creation of a full time Dog Warden is estimated at c £24.5k (including on costs) plus transport (£3.5k). Total costs estimate c. £28k. (All subject to job). It is assumed that the cost of back office support (HR, Finance, Legal, Communications, etc.) can be absorbed. 3. Budget funding gap therefore £15k, with resources yet to be identified. 4. Any such post requires further operational evaluation to ensure an efficient, effective and economic fit with Operations and wider Corporate Priorities. 	Date: 1 st March 2017
