# 5. BACKGROUND AND OPTIONS

#### Part 6 Page 259 – Members' Allowances Scheme and Part 3 Page 40 Terms of Reference of the Licensing Committee

5.1 A special responsibility allowance of £1671 is paid to both the Chair of Licensing and the Vice-chair of Licensing as the allocation of duties is split. The Chair of Licensing covers the full Licensing Committee meetings (and any other duties associated with the Licensing remit) and the Vice-chair covers the sub-committee meetings.

# 5.2 From 9<sup>th</sup> November the Chair of the Licensing Committee will resume full responsibility for

the work of the Licensing Committee and sub-committees.

- 5.3 It is therefore proposed to amend the Members' Allowances Scheme and the Constitution to reflect these changes and to return the £3,342 special responsibility allowance to the Chair of Licensing with effect from 10<sup>th</sup> November 2017.
- 5.4 It is also proposed to reinstate the one off payment of £150 should the Vice-chair of Licensing be required to chair a Full Licensing Committee meeting.
- 5.5 Appendix A details the proposed changes.
- 5.6 The members of the Independent Remuneration Panel have been consulted on this proposal and were in unanimous agreement with the changes.

#### Part 3 Page 40 – Terms of Reference of the Licensing Committee

Sub-committees will be made up of Licensing Committee members, or if substitutes are required (on the non-statutory committee only), any other member may substitute by agreement with the Chief Executive that the member has undertaken the necessary training to take part in the committees work. The Vice-cChair of the Licensing Committee will act as the chair person for all Licensing Sub-Committee meetings, otherwise the CVice-chair of Licensing will fulfil this role where available. They will automatically chair the sub-committees without the need to be formally appointed as the chair person.
