Completed applications for a new vehicle licence will only normally be accepted in respect of vehicles that are less than 5 years of age from the date of first registration or are less than 7 years of age where its emissions comply with the current Euro Emission standard (as amended from time to time) or emissions have been reduced to comply with that Euro Emission standard by means of an approved conversion kit.

Mr David Wilson spoke on the item and answered questions for clarification from members.

Discussion took place on the item and the Licensing Manager provided clarification as summarised below;
