- 2. The Public Protection Manager has delegated authority to extend your licence up to a period of 3 months to allow you to book and pass both the tests.
- 3. The driver was informed of his right of appeal to the Magistrates' Court which must be exercised within 21 days of service of the decision letter upon him.
- 4. The driver would be informed of the reason for the decision and would receive written confirmation of the Council's decision.

The matter had been considered in accordance with the Council's approved procedure, the Council's Guidelines on Convictions, Byelaws relating to Hackney Carriages and the Sub-Committee took into account all the relevant information put before them.
