There were, however, some aspects of the report which the Panel felt could be revised which you will wish to consider before publication:

- The Panel suggested removing the word 'only' from the footnote on page 77;
- It may be helpful if the recommendation in relation to health information could be made more specific;
- The Panel felt that less acronyms would help the reader more easily follow the narrative in the report;
- The Panel queried the accuracy of the statement in paragraph 1.7 regarding the coroner's inquest.

The Panel does not need to review another version of the report, but I would be grateful if you could include our letter as an appendix to the report.
