Public Space Protection Order



Maximum Number of Dogs

Rossendale Borough Council hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order came into force on 19th August 2019 and was extended for a further 3 years from 18th August 2022.
- 2. This Order applies to land specified in Schedule 1.

Offence

- 3. (1) A person in charge of a dog on land referred to in Schedule 1 of this Order, shall be guilty of an offence, if, at any time, he/she does not comply with a direction given to him by an Authorised Officer of the Council to produce a device for or other suitable means of removing dog faeces and transporting it to a bin (whether or not the dog has defecated) unless
 - a. That person has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so.
 - (2) Nothing in this article applies to a person who
 - a. is registered as a blind person in a register compiled under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948; or
 - b. has a disability which affects his mobility, manual dexterity, physical co-ordination or ability to lift, carry or otherwise move everyday objects, in respect of a dog trained by a prescribed charity and upon which he relies for assistance.
 - (3) For the purposes of this article
 - a. a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog
 - b. each of the following is a "prescribed charity"
 - i. Dogs for the Disabled (registered charity number 700454)
 - ii. Support Dogs (registered charity number 1088281)
 - iii. Canine Partners for Independence (registered charity number 803680)

Penalty

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under Article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
