We will promote all licensing objectives by training staff in responsible alcohol sales, maintaining CCTV, managing noise levels, enforcing Challenge 25 and ensuring safety measures like clear exits and first aid availability. Children will be supervised and only allowed during appropriate hours.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
Staff will be trained to refuse service to intoxicated or underage individuals. CCTV will be in operation and incidents will be logged. We will work closely with local authorities and promote a safe, respectable environment.
c) Public safety
We will maintain clear emergency exits, provide first aid kits and ensure staff are trained in basic safety procedures. The premises will comply with all health and safety regulations to protect customers and staff.
d) The prevention of public nuisance
We will monitor music volume, manage outdoor areas to reduce noise and display signage encouraging customers to leave quietly. Events will be scheduled to avoid disturbance to nearby residents.
All windows are closed at all times and the entrance door is always closed, preventing noise escaping the building.
e) The protection of children from harm
We will enforce Challenge 25, ensure staff are trained to prevent underage alcohol sales, and allow children on-site only during appropriate hours under adult supervision.
