#### a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)

The premises will be operated in a responsible manner at all times to uphold the licensing objectives.

The management team is committed to working with local authorities and enforcement agencies to ensure the café remains a safe and welcoming environment for the community. We would like to remain a part of Safer Rossendale.

### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A suitable CCTV system shall be installed and maintained in good working order, covering all areas to which the public have access. Recordings shall be kept for a minimum of 28 days and made available to authorised officers upon request.

Staff will receive training on recognising and handling potential conflict situations, refusing service to intoxicated persons, and ensuring the safe dispersal of customers at closing time.

#### c) Public safety

All exits and escape routes will be kept clear and well-lit.

Staff will receive health and safety training, including fire procedures and first aid awareness.

The premises will maintain appropriate fire safety equipment, emergency lighting, and signage.

#### d) The prevention of public nuisance

Background music will be played at a reasonable level so as not to cause disturbance to nearby residents or businesses.

Signage will be displayed requesting customers to leave the premises quietly and respect the neighbours.

Waste disposal, deliveries, and collections will only be between 9am - 8:30pm

## e) The protection of children from harm

A Challenge 21 policy will be operated, requiring anyone who appears under 21 to produce valid photo ID before being served alcohol.

All staff involved in alcohol sales will receive training in age verification procedures and the refusal of service where appropriate.
