The premises also includes darts, karaoke, pool and shuffleboard facilities, together with customer seating, reception, toilets and changing facilities. The venue is intended to operate as a relaxed, family-friendly sports and leisure venue, with the bar forming part of the overall customer experience rather than operating as a standalone drinking venue.

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d, e) (please read guidance note 9)

The premises will operate as a family friendly indoor sports and leisure venue
Management and staff will actively promote the licensing objectives through appropriate policies, staff training, supervision of the premises and regular review of operating procedures

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A digital CCTV System will be installed and maintained throughout the premises, covering all public areas and entrances/ exits. Recordings will be retained for a minimum of 28 days and made available to authorised officers upon request.

Staff will be trained in responsible alcohol retailing and a refusals register will be maintained

Any incidents of crime or disorder will be recorded and reported where appropriate

We will be operating a zero-tolerance policy towards illegal drugs on the premises.

Anyone found using, supplying or in possession of illegal drugs may be asked to leave and may be banned from the premises. Where necessary, the police will be contacted.

Staff will be made aware of the signs of possible drug use or dealing and will report any concerns to the manager or DPS.

To help prevent drug-related activity, we will:

- Monitor the premises through staff supervision and CCTV.
- Carry out regular checks of toilets and other areas where drug use may take place.
- Refuse entry or remove anyone where there are reasonable concerns regarding drugs.
- Record any drug-related incidents in the premises incident log.
- Keep relevant CCTV footage following any serious incident.
- Contact Lancashire Police where drugs are found, dealing is suspected or there are any wider safety concerns.

Any suspected drugs found or handed to staff will be kept secure and dealt with in accordance with police advice.

We will also take reports of drink or drug spiking seriously. Anyone who believes they may have been spiked will be supported by staff, kept in a safe area where possible and the police or ambulance service will be contacted where required.

Staff will not put themselves at risk when dealing with suspected drug-related incidents.

This policy applies to customers, members, guests, contractors and staff.

The policy will be reviewed as required and following any serious incident or advice from the Police or Licensing Authority

c) Public safety

The premises will comply with all relevant fire safety, health and safety and building regulation.

Emergency exits will be clearly marked and maintained free from obstruction

Appropriate first aid facilities will be available and staff will be trained in emergency procedures.

Occupancy levels will be monitored and managed to public safety

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Management will take all reasonable steps to prevent public nuisance arising from the operation of the premises

Music levels will be controlled and customers will be encouraged to leave the premises quietly.

Regular checks will be carried out to ensure noise does not cause unreasonable disturbance to neighbouring properties

e) The protection of children from harm

The premises will operate a challenge 25 age verification policy.
Anyone appearing under the age of 25 will be required to produce acceptable photographic identification before being served alcohol.
Children under the age of 16 will be monitored by a responsible adult unless participating in the organised sporting activities.
Staff will be trained in the protection of children from harm and all relevant licencing requirements
